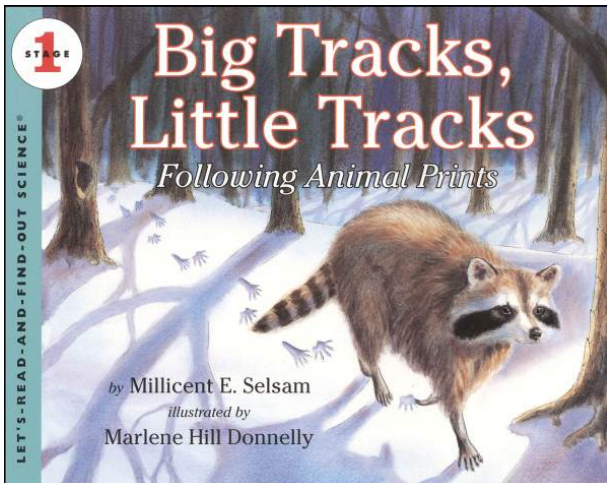

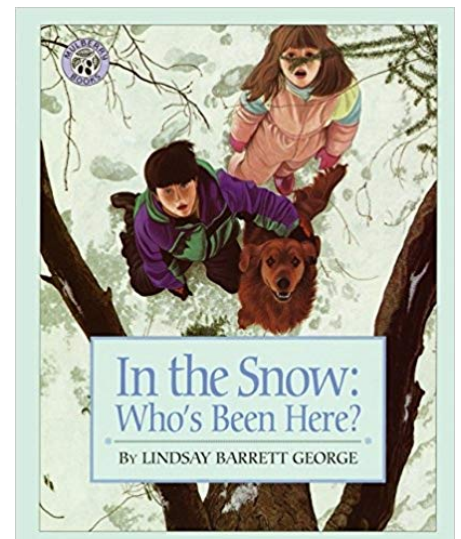
Animal Tracks in Winter

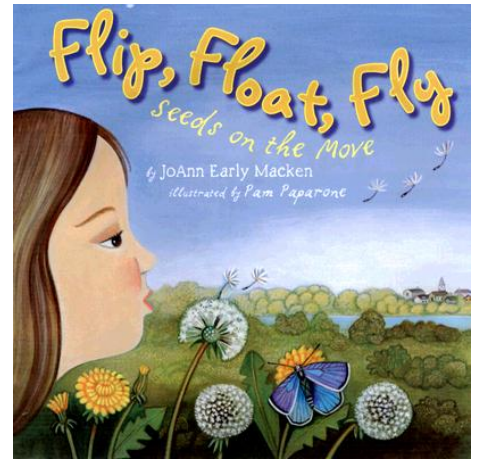
Getting Ready for Winter

We will look at animals that migrate, hibernate, and stay active during the wintertime and take a closer look at the footprints we might find in the snow! All about seeds!

Host a reading of *Flip, Float, Fly: Seeds on the Move* by JoAnn Early Macken accompanied by an activity where each child will create their own seed bombs to take home and plant! The lesson is geared toward K-4th graders.

Host a reading of *Why Do Leaves Change Color* by Betsy Maestro accompanied by an activity where each child will create their own leaf collage! The lesson is geared toward K-4th graders.
